#### JOB DESCRIPTION

#### **SUMMARY DESCRIPTION:**

The Shelter floor staff directly supports youth voluntarily staying at a HOPE youth shelter in Aberdeen, WA.

This position will play a critical role in assuring the shelter's efficient operation, working to sustain a safe environment and healthy culture needed to support successful stays and exits for youth utilizing the shelter. Must be 21 years of age or older to be employed. The on-call position requires flexibility and the ability to respond to various schedule changes, filling in for employee vacations as well as call-outs due to sickness.

The shelter provides temporary residence, assessment, referrals, and permanency planning services for unsheltered youth under the age of 18.

## **FUNCTIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. Maintains a positive and healthy community for youth in care.
- 2. Provides guidance for youth to maintain safe and positive behavior.
- 3. Ensures that shelters operate effectively and in compliance with all relevant rules and regulations.
- 4. Maintains program structure and provides clear and consistent expectations.
- 5. Documents shelter operations and support to individuals.
- 6. Maintains calm therapeutic presence during escalated situations.
- 7. Supports lead advocate and other supervisors in providing conflict resolution for youth.
- 8. Reports issues or concerns to designated Supervisors.
- 9. Completes incident reports and notifies appropriate parties when necessary.
- 10. Prepares nutritionally balanced meals for and with youth.
- 11. Successfully completes all required training.
- 12. Participates in staff meetings.
- 13. Provides other direct support to sheltering youth as directed.
- 14. Completes other duties as assigned.

## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. 21 years of age or older
- 2. High School Diploma/GED
- 3. Professional experience supporting youth who are homeless and housing insecure. Lived experience may substitute.

- 4. Ability to pass and maintain a background check.
- 5. Current WA Driver's License and auto insurance. Clear driving record is required.
- 6. Excellent written and oral communication skills.

# PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Bachelor's degree in relevant field.
- 2. Minimum two years' professional experience supporting at-risk youth.
- 3. Lived experience successfully navigating from homelessness.
- 4. Bilingual English/ Spanish.
- 5. Proficiency in utilizing the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS).
- 6. Training in Motivational Interviewing and Trauma-Informed Care.
- 7. Proficiency in Microsoft Office suite.
- 8. Other cultural competencies that enhance CCAP's capacity to engage and support diversity in client cultures and experience.

**LOCATION/WORKING HOURS:** The HOPE Youth Shelter is located in Aberdeen, WA. The shelter operates continuously, 7 days per week, 24 hrs per day.

This position is subject to pre-employment drug testing and requires an FBI background check.
